Biography:

SAMUEL C. HYLER, who enjoyed the honorable distinction of being the oldest man in Franklin township, when this biography was written in 1907. At that time he owned two fine farms, one of 64 and the other of 20 acres. His residence is on the latter, which is located in section 21. Mr. Hyler was born in Fairfield County, Ohio, September 5, 1818, and was the only child of his parents, Samuel Curtis and Margaret (Bartholomew) Hyler.

Samuel Curtis Hyler was born in Delaware and moved to Fairfield County, Ohio, in young manhood, where he married Margaret Bartholomew, a native of Virginia. He engaged in farming in Richland County, and died there when his only child was very small. The mother subsequently married Jacob Cromer, who had come to this neighborhood from Virginia, and they had two children, Caroline and Lucinda. Caroline married (first) Ryan Carter, and (second) Joshua Roberts-all are now deceased. Lucinda married Peter Woodring and is now deceased.

Samuel C. Hyler, our subject, was left a lonely little boy of nine years when his mother died. He was then compelled to work around with different farmers, making his own way the best lie could, and attending school at rare intervals, but by the time he was 22 years old lie had become a

capable farmer. He married Mary Ann Barbe, who was of an old Virginia family, but was born in Fairfield County, Ohio. They had 11 children, namely: Margaret, who married (first) John Cicle, and (second) John Koon, and lives at St. Mary. Henry Hyler, who died in the civil war at Murphreesboro, TN at the battle of Stones River in December of 1863, Lucinda who was married to Washington C. History of the Ohio 99th Regiment

Organized August 26, 1862, under Colonel Albert Longworthy, it soon proceeded to Kentucky and took part in the defense of Louisville. After coming under the command of Colonel Peter T. Swaine, formerly of the 15th Regulars, it pursued Bragg southward and operated against John Morgan, an in December took part in the battle of Stone River. At Chickamauga it was engaged both days with considerable loss. In November, 1864, it participated in the battles of Lookout Mountain and Mission Ridge, and in May, 1864, started with Thomas' army on the Atlanta campaign, fighting at Rocky Face Ridge, Kenesaw, Atlanta, Jonesboro and Lovejoy. At Kenesaw it held a ridge against desperate assaults of the enemy, and the men fired an average of one hundred rounds. It pursued Hood northward and joined Thomas at Nashville, taking active part in the battle at that place. It followed Hood as far as Columbia, where the Regiment was consolidated with the 50th Ohio. From Dyer's Compendium 99th Regiment Infantry. Organized at Camp Lima, Allen County, Ohio, and mustered in August 26, 1862. Ordered to Lexington, Ky., August 31, thence moved to Cynthiana, Ky., September 3, thence to Covington, Ky., and to Louisville, Ky., September 17.
